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# **Product Description**

The MPC-11 antibody (IgG2b, kappa) is suitable for use as an isotype-matched control antibody in several applications to estimate the degree of non-specific binding by an antigen-specific antibody. Ideally, the isotype control should have the same subclass of heavy chain (IgA, IgD, IgE, IgG, or IgM) and light chain (kappa or lambda) as the specific antibody being used. If a conjugated antibody is used, an isotype control conjugated to the same molecule (e.g. fluorochrome) should be chosen. The use of an appropriate isotype control helps confirm the specificity of the antigen-specific antibody, and indicates non-specific binding that may result from binding to Fc receptors or other cell components. The myeloma cell line secreting the MPC-11 antibody was derived from the transplantable Merwin Plasmacytoma-11 cell line, which was induced by implantation of a plastic diffusion chamber into a BALB/c mouse. This product has unknown binding specificity, having been screened on a variety of activated, resting, live, and fixed tissues from several species, including mouse, rat, human, and non-human primates.


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
